

TWC GENERAL MEETING     May 5th, 2010

President Deanna Hanson called the Meeting of the Torrance Woman's Club to order on May 5th, 2010, at 11:00 a.m.

  - 200. to Cheer for Children

4. TWC give \$1,250. to Ron Spears for his year-end bonus.
5. TWC hold Mexican Train games at the Clubhouse on Monday, June 14<sup>th</sup> at 1 p.m. Charge would be \$5.00; money going to a local charity.

The recommendations were seconded and approved. The complete minutes of the April 7th, 2010 general meeting have been posted.

Treasurer, Jeaninne Glomboske, read the treasurer's report for March. As of March 31st, 2010, there was a balance of \$18,661.94 in the general account and \$689.80 in the clubhouse account. Report will be filed with the minutes.
