Roberta Smith did an amazing job as chairing the Gift Wrapping at Barnes & Noble keeping it organized

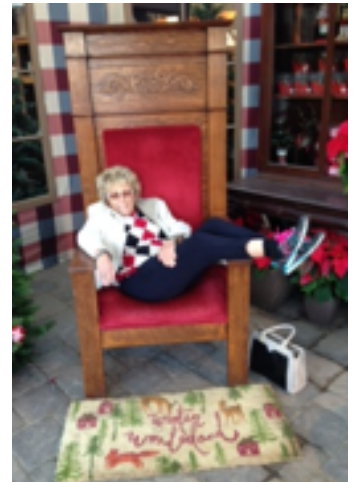
& scheduling people to wrap was a huge responsibility and she is a shining star. She will give us the results at the January meeting.
