Photography Contest Information

All you shutter bugs get ready for this contest.

Clubs must bring their entries to the March Marina District Council Meeting at the Santa Monica Bay Woman's Club, March 18, 2016 for display and judging.

There are 2 contests at CFWC Convention: The World in Pictures and Volunteers in Action. Each District may submit one item in color and one item in black & white for the World in Pictures in each category, and each club may submit one entry for Volunteers in Action.

Student Photography age groups are 6-8, 9-12 and graduating senior. Categories are Living Things, Scenes and still life. Color and Black & White in each category

A NOTE ABOUT PHOTO MOUNTING:

Rigid mount board may be found at places such as Michael's and Aaron Brothers and cut to fit. Acid free spray adhesive is also available at these stores. An alternative is to print directly onto lightweight board. Local UPS stores have this service.

Each submission must be an 8 x 11 inch print. All photos must be mounted on a rigid 8 x 10 inch board**; overall thickness not to exceed 3/8 inch. Do not submit photos with mattes or frames, or hangers on the back. They will be disqualified.

Photos must be taken during the contest year: January 1 through December 31
